If a student is placed directly into MAT 143 or 161 due to the MPE score, a grade of C must be earned and the MAT 113 requirement becomes a free elective.

To qualify for graduation, a student must take at least 30 of their last 60 credits at West Chester University. In addition, a student must take at least 50% of the courses in their major or minor discipline (excluding cognate courses) at West Chester University. For active-duty service members, the academic residency requirements will not exceed 25% of the undergraduate degree program. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required to graduate.
