Employer Survey for Initial and Advanced-Level Educator Preparation Programs – Results

The following tables include responses to questions from employers of West Chester University of Pennsylvania teacher candidate program graduates. The employer survey was administered online via Skyfactor Benchworks from February 3-20, 2021. The number of employers sent surveys was 203 and the number of employers who responded was 19. This resulted in a survey response rate of 9.4%. The data tables display results on employers’ satisfaction with program graduates and their preparation.
