The West Chester University Resource Pantry supports student success by **minimizing food and basic need insecurity** and preparing students for life after graduation. The pantry offers non-perishable food, fresh produce, personal care items, school supplies, as well as professional and winter attire.

Who Can Shop?



Any student (undergraduate & graduate) is welcome to shop at the pantry. The pantry **does not require** the student to provide documentation or **proof of income**. Students only need to provide their WCU ID number. No student will be turned away from the pantry.

Operating Hours



Monday-Friday | 10am-4pm

The Pantry is typically open **Monday-Friday from 10am- 4pm** during the fall and spring terms. The pantry has **reduced hours** during break periods, including summer, allowing students to shop all year-round. Updated hours can be found on our website: www.wcupa.edu/pantry

Pantry Location



The Resource Pantry is housed in the Center for Civic Engagement & Social Impact in **Commonwealth Hall**, accessible through the "**Student Health Services**" entrance on the ground floor.

Pantry Process



- **First-time** customers fill out registration form
- A **tour** of the pantry will be provided
- Students may then **shop** at the pantry
- Items will be checked out at the desk for **no charge**
